Coptic stitching is a form of bookbinding that dates back to the 2nd century AD. With a beautiful open spine, you will master the kettle stitch and learn how to attach chipboard covers. Once you finish binding your 64 page journal, you'll move on to creating a steampunk chic cover working with aluminum foil tape, dry embossing, washers and more. Coptic stitched books have pages that lay perfectly flat when opened so this book would make a fabulous journal, agenda, sketchbook etc.

Terrific Techniques



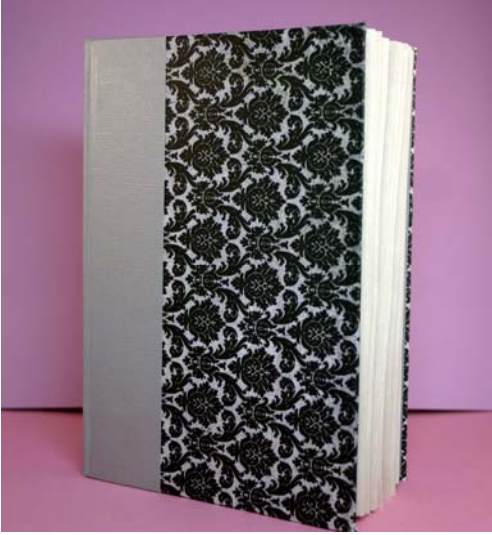
